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Abstract

This document is provided to help you understand how to enter and maintain student health information in the Health module of CAMS Enterprise. The Health Module consists of a single multi-purpose window (Student Health Maintenance) and three related CAMS functions: document tracking, holds, and reports.

With the Student Health Maintenance screen you can create and maintain an in-depth medical record for students. The following information can be stored in student health records:

- Immunization history
- Medical history
- Lab tests
- Physical examinations and examination history
- Medication

Document tracking allows you to add a pre-defined sequence of documents to a health record.

Holds allow you to place a hold on a student's records for health purposes.

Reports allow you to print out detailed or physical health records.

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Student Health Maintenance

Creating Immunization Records

Use the Shots tab to record student immunization records.



Step-By-Step: Create a Student Immunization Record

1. From the **CAMS Enterprise Home** page, click **Health>Maintain**. The Student Health Maintenance window will open with the Shots tab displayed.

3. Click **Yes** or **No** to indicate whether additional ailments exist in the Other Problems Not Listed field.
4. If you wish to record whether a student lived in a foreign country, enter the country name.
5. Use the Explanations field to enter additional information or explanations about ailments.
6. Click another tab if you wish to record additional information, or close the window to save the information to the database, or click **Cancel** to exit without saving the data.

Recording Test Information

Use the Tests tab to record information regarding lab tests and lab test results.



Step-By-Step: Record Student Lab Tests

1. From the **CAMS Enterprise Home** page, click **Health>Maintain**. The Student Health Maintenance window will open with the Shots tab displayed. Click the **Tests** tab.

Maintaining Physical Examination History

Use the Physicals tab to record student physical examination history. You may also highlight the appropriate physical record and click **Print**. A detailed Student Health Report displays.



Step-By-Step: Record Physical Examination History

1. From the **CAMS Enterprise Home** page, click **Health>Maintain**. The Student Health Maintenance window will open with the Shots tab displayed. Click the Physicals tab. Any physical examinations recorded for the student display in the Physical Records grid.

Student Health BYOR

Information entered into the Student Health Module can be extracted and will display in a detailed report if desired. Reports can be generated for a single student or for multiple students.



Step-By-Step: Generate Detailed Student Health Reports

1. From the **CAMS Enterprise Home** page, click **Health>Reports**. The Health BYOR window will appear.
2. Select the Report Format, then select either Single or Multiple students. If single student is selected, use the search icon to access the Select Student window. If multiple students are selected, choose any desired sort criteria.
3. Click **Print** to generate the report.

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
